

## Registration for exams

Before an exam can be taken, an application for the exam must be submitted to Examination office.

This is done via the online system **QIS** of Leibniz Universität Hannover.

The exam registration dates change every semester, the dates can be found on the homepage of the examination office.

The application dates for the summer and wintersemester semester, for the study programs **mathematics, physics, nanotechnologies, quantum engineering** and **meteorology** are:

### Wintersemester:

Registration period VbP*	15.10. – 31.10.
Examination period VbP*	01.11. – 28.02.
Registration period 1 (any other form of exam)**	15.11. – 30.11.
Examination period variant 2 (any other form of exam) 1.PZ**	15.12. – 28.02.
Registration period 2 (any other form of exam)**	16.03. – 23.03.
Examination period variant 2 (any other form of exam) 2.PZ**	24.03. – 14.04.

### Summersemester:

Registration period VbP*	15.04. – 30.04.
Examination period VbP*	01.05. – 31.08.
Registration period 1 (any other form of exam)**	15.05. – 31.05.
Examination period variant 2 (any other form of exam) 1.PZ**	15.06. – 31.08.
Registration period 2 (any other form of exam)**	16.09. – 23.09.
Examination period variant 2 (any other form of exam) 2.PZ**	24.09. – 14.10.

The reporting periods for the tests **must be strictly adhered to!** Subsequent registrations are generally not possible. Without registration you are excluded from the exams!

You **can withdraw** from a registered examination. Take out the registration rules from your **examination regulations**. If you have already made an appointment with an examiner for oral exams, please inform the examiner as soon as possible about the withdrawal!

An exam registration is only valid for the **immediatly following exam period**. If you withdraw from the examination, you will have to re-register for the examination in a later registration period.
